Dear Colleague,

It is a pleasure for us to welcome you to the 7th Milan Breast Cancer Conference - a conference of **innovations in patient care**. Its aim is to facilitate discussions between faculty members and audience and to promote interaction on controversial issues on diagnosis, treatment strategies and disease prevention. The seventh assembly of this conference will aspire, as in the past, at allowing a friendly, stimulating environment for the presentation of innovation, ongoing and future research on breast cancer.

This year's conference will again provide the opportunity to listen to experts present the most up-to-date information in a variety of fields. Among the opening arguments of interest you may find breast cancer detection and staging, innovation in imaging for early diagnosis, for identification of multiple sites of disease and for monitoring response to therapies. A main part on the conference's program is traditionally breast cancer surgery, which is continuously being refined and better targeted to allow the maximum respect for a woman's body image and wellbeing and with the minimal damage to normal tissues. Refinements of multidisciplinary approaches include surgery, intra and postoperative radiation therapy to obtain the best local disease control and minimize the side effects of proper treatment. These include sentinel node biopsies, nipple sparing approaches and reduced duration of radiotherapy to the conserved breast. Part of such programs include also preoperative systemic therapies aimed at allowing a more efficient control of local disease and at obtaining information on tumor regression with specific therapies. Another important item on the program relates to the process of malignant transformation. Histopathological assessment, genetics and molecular pathology are more then before integrated into therapeutic decision making strategies. The highlights of the St. Gallen Conference 2005 will be reported to provide details on recommendations of experts on how much future might be viewed as standard. It is tradition that reporting innovations of care at the Milan Breast Cancer Conference challenge these recommendations.

Milan, a capital of breast cancer research, has now built up a tradition of being a venue for innovation. Reports on new surgical approaches, improved radiation treatments, and advances in medical therapies are a guarantee for an exciting and fruitful discussion.
